Erik Berglöv is Chief Economist and Special Adviser to the President at the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development since 2006. He has previously held the position of Director of the Stockholm Institute of Transition Economics (SITE) and Professor at the Stockholm School of Economics from 2000 to 2005. In 2005 he was appointed Senior Fellow at The Brookings Institution. He was also Assistant Professor at the Université Libre de Bruxelles and has held visiting positions at Harvard, Stanford and MIT.

He is a widely published and internationally respected specialist in the field of financial development and transition economics. His focus has been on policy-related issues in transition economies and he has regularly provided advice to national governments and international institutions including the IMF and the World Bank.

Erik Berglöv was the founder and President of the Centre for Economic and Financial Research (CEFIR) in Moscow and a Programme Director at the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR) in London.
