



Yannis S. Costopoulos

Yannis S. Costopoulos is Chairman of the Board of Directors of Alpha Bank.

Alpha Bank was formed after the acquisition of the Ionian and Popular Bank - the oldest Bank operating in Greece - by Alpha Credit Bank.

Born in Athens in 1938, Mr. Costopoulos received his B.Sc. in Naval Architecture at King's College, Durham University, England. He is the grandson of the founder of the Commercial Credit Bank, as Alpha Bank was called when he joined it in 1963. From 1973 to 1984 he served as Managing Director and General Manager, from 1984 to 1996 as Chairman of the Board of Directors and General Manager and from 1996 to February 2005 as Chairman of the Board of Directors and Managing Director. Since March 2005 Mr. Costopoulos is Chairman of the Board of Directors of Alpha Bank.

Mr. Costopoulos is Chairman of the Board of Directors of Ionian Hotel Enterprises, a Member of the Board of the Institute of International Finance and a Member of the International Monetary Conference.

He is also Chairman of the J. F. Costopoulos Foundation, a Member of the Board of Patrons of the European Association for Banking and Financial History, Vice Chairman of the Benaki Museum, an Honorary Trustee of the Metropolitan Museum of Art and Chairman of the Board of Directors of the National Garden of Athens.
