



Mr. Alexey V. Ulyukaev is First Deputy Chairman and Member of the Board of Directors of the Bank of Russia.

Mr. Alexey V. Ulyukaev was born in 1956 in Moscow. He graduated from Economics Faculty of the Lomonosov Moscow State University, where he subsequently finished a post-graduate course and was awarded a Sc.D. degree in economics in 1982. He also holds a PhD in economics from University Pierre-Mendes in France, Grenoble.

Mr. Alexey V. Ulyukaev started his professional career as professor's assistant and associate professor at the Moscow Construction Engineering Institute. Later, he became consultant and section head of the editorial office of the Kommunist magazine and political analyst of the Moskovskiye Novosti (Moscow News) weekly.

In 1991, Mr. Ulyukaev began to work for the government institutions, first as economic advisor to the Russian Government and then head of the group of advisors to the Chairman of the Russian Federation Government. He served as Deputy Director of the Institute of Economic Problems of the Transition Period and as Deputy of the Moscow City Duma. From 2000 to 2004, he was First Deputy Minister of Finance of the Russian Federation. Since 2004, Mr. Ulyukaev has held the post of First Deputy Chairman of the Bank of Russia.
