#### Biographical note:

Konstantinos Megalokonomou was born in Smyrna, Asia Minor, in 1914. At the age of eight, after the Asia Minor Disaster of 1922, he settled in Athens with his family. He took up photojournalism while still in high school, initially working with his brothers, Manolis and Charalambos. After 1936, he and his brothers founded the photo agency Megalokonomou Brothers Photojournalism (later renamed Greek Photographic News -K. Megalokonomou), located initially at 13, Anthimou Gazi street, Athens, and then at Karytsi square. He was one of the leading Greek photojournalists, with a continuous active presence in news photography until the end of his life in 1992.

#### CONTENT

The Archive contains records that capture the main operations and activities of the Bank of Greece and its relationship with Greek society. More specifically, it contains photographs by K. Megalokonomou from the General Meetings of Bank of Greece Shareholders of the years 1950-1987, the participation of Governors and Deputy Governors of the Bank in international agreements and conferences, the visits of prominent guests to the Bank, and events organised or attended by the Bank's Administration and the Bank of Greece Employees' Union (SYTE).

#### **ARRANGEMENT**

The material has been arranged into one series, A8S1: Photographic and audiovisual archive, Konstantinos Megalokonomou Collection. The files have been arranged in thematic and chronological order. All records have been retained.
