Paul Mylonas is currently Chief Economist of the Group, General Manager Strategy and Research, and Head of Investor Relations at the National Bank of Greece. He is Secretary of the Executive Committee and a member of the ALCO Committee of the Bank. From 1995 – 2000, he held the position of senior economist in the Economics Department of the OECD where he worked in the Money and Finance Division, and was head of the Greek and Spanish desks. He also served as the OECD representative on the G-10 Secretariat during 1999-2000. Prior to that, he worked at the International Monetary Fund (1987-1995). There, as a senior economist, he was the desk officer for Poland in the European Department. He also worked in the Fund's Policy Development and Review Department. From 1985-1987, he was visiting Assistant Professor at the Department of Economics in Boston University. He holds a PhD and MA in Economics (Princeton University) and B.Sc. in Applied Mathematics – Economics (Brown University).
