

# PERSONAL DATA PRIVACY NOTICE

(Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council)

We hereby inform persons that submit applications for admission to the Bank of Greece Regulatory Sandbox that we keep a record of and process the personal data provided.

## Purpose of processing and Legal Basis

The purpose of this processing of personal data is communication with the representatives of institutions / firms within the scope of the Executive Committee Act 189/1/14.05.2021 (hereinafter the "Act") for activities pursuant to the Act. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the exercise of official authority vested in the controller (Article 6 par. 1 (e) of GDPR).

The personal data we collect and process include identification information (name and surname) and contact information (post address, e-mail address, telephone number). Such personal data may be processed by automated and/or manual means.

## Recipients

The Bank of Greece shall process the data collected. Such personal data shall not be disclosed or transmitted to any third party, except for third parties that provide support services to the Bank of Greece. Above personal data are processed only by authorized staff of the Bank of Greece, who have been made fully aware of their relevant obligations under the law and the applicable rules of conduct.

## Representatives of the Data Controller

For matters concerning personal data, the Bank of Greece will be represented by the Data Protection Officer of the Bank of Greece (email: <u>dpo@bankofgreece.gr</u>).

#### Data retention period

The Bank of Greece will keep the abovementioned personal data in its records while recipients represent Institutions during the conduct of a test in the Sandbox as prescribed by the Act, and for up to two years after they cease to act as Institution representatives or after the conclusion of the test.

#### Rights of data subjects

Under the applicable legislation, all persons involved under the capacity of data subjects have the following rights in respect of their personal data: the right to rectify and erase; the right to restrict processing; the right to object to any processing; the right to revoke an approval given; and the right to data portability. In order to exercise these rights, the data subject must contact the Bank of Greece and its aforementioned representatives in writing, clearly indicating his/her full identification details.

The data subject has also the right to lodge a complaint with the Hellenic Data Protection Authority.
