Reverse: Asclepius (intaglio printing)

Colouring: purple

Dimensions: 153x77mm.

Paper security features:

Watermark, head of King Philip of Macedonia.

Security thread.

Randomly distributed security fibres.

5.000-DRACHMA NOTE

(circulating alongside the older note of the same denomination, issued on 23 March 1984).

Theme: Greek War of Independence (1821).

Main Design:

Front: General Theodoros Kolokotronis (intaglio printing)

Reverse: the town of Karytena (wet offset printing).

Colouring: deep blue

Dimensions: 147x74mm.

Paper security features:

Watermark, head of King Philip of Macedonia.

Electrotype watermark.

Security thread.

Randomly distributed security fibres.

1.000-DRACHMA NOTE

Theme: Ancient Olympia, birthplace of the Olympic Games

Main Design:

Front: Head of Apollo (intaglio printing)

Reverse: Temple of Hera at Ancient Olympia and Discobolus (discus thrower) by Myron (intaglio printing).

Colouring: brown

Dimensions: 158x77mm.

Paper security features:

- Watermark, head of Charioteer of Delphi.
- Security thread.

Date of issue: 1 July 1987



500-DRACHMA NOTE

Theme: The first Governor in Greece after the War of Independence (1821) agricultural development

Main Design:

Front: Ioannis Capodistrias (intaglio printing).

Reverse: The Citadel of Corfu (intaglio printing).

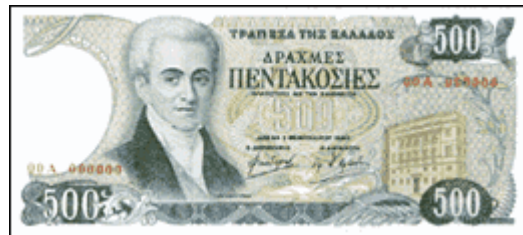
Colouring: green
