In 1983 he joined Banca d'Italia and until 1990 he worked in several areas of the Banking Supervision Department of Banca d'Italia. In 1991-92 he was seconded as a national expert at DG XV of the European Commission (Securities Markets Division). At the end of 1994 he was seconded to the European Monetary Institute as Secretary of the Banking Supervisory Sub-Committee. In June 1998, he was appointed Head of the Prudential Supervision Division at the European Central Bank (ECB), in charge of carrying out the tasks of the ECB in the fields of prudential supervision and financial stability. In February 2003, he was appointed Director of the Directorate Financial Stability and Supervision. He is currently Director General of the Directorate General Financial Stability and is responsible for the area of financial stability at the ECB.
