Dejan Šoškic, Governor, National Bank of Serbia

Mr Dejan Šoškić was appointed Governor of the National Bank of Serbia on 28 July 2010 by the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia for a term of six years and began his term of office on 29 July 2010.

Prior to this position, Mr Šoškić served as a special financial markets adviser in the National Bank of Yugoslavia, economic policy adviser in the EU Policy and Legal Advice Centre (from 2002 until 2003), and was a member of the Council of the National Bank of Serbia (from 2003 until 2004) and chairman until 28 July 2010.

Dejan Šoškic holds a PhD degree from Belgrade University, Faculty of Economics. He has worked as an associate professor at the Faculty of Economics in Belgrade and as a lecturer for graduate and MBA courses at the University of Nebraska, Omaha, teaching financial markets and institutions, financial management and international business and economics. In 2002, he was a guest lecturer at the universities of New Haven, Rhode Island and Berkeley, USA.

Mr Šoškić is a Fulbright alumnus and member of the presidency of the Scientific Association of Economists in Serbia.
