

PERSONAL DATA PRIVACY NOTICE

(Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council)

We hereby inform persons submitting information to the Bank of Greece FinTech Innovation Hub, that we keep a record of and process the personal data provided.

Purpose of processing

The purpose of this processing of personal data is to enable a constructive dialogue with firms and/or natural persons involved in FinTech activities and wishing to receive non-binding instructions and assistance from the Bank of Greece.

For above purpose we collect and process personal data of persons participating in the Hub without which it would not be possible to enable above constructive dialogue. The personal data we collect and process include the following: identification data (name and surname); contact details (postal address, e-mail address, telephone number); personal data stemming from information which the participants submitted in the Hub. Such personal data are not forwarded or notified to other entities or persons, other than the competent Bank of Greece handlers, except in cases when an express approval by the data providers is granted. Such personal data may be processed by automated and/or manual means.

Recipients

The Bank of Greece shall process the data collected. Such personal data shall not be disclosed or transmitted to any third party. Above personal data are processed only by authorized staff of the Bank of Greece, who have been made fully aware of their relevant obligations under the law and the applicable rules of conduct.

Data retention period

The Bank of Greece will keep the abovementioned personal data in its records for as long as it is required for the purposes of the Hub.



Rights of data subjects

Under the applicable legislation, all persons involved under the capacity of data subjects have the following rights in respect of their personal data: the right to rectify and erase; the right to restrict processing; the right to object to any processing; the right to revoke an approval given; and the right to data portability. In order to exercise these rights, the data subject must contact the Bank of Greece and its aforementioned representatives in writing, clearly indicating his/her full identification details.

The data subject has also the right to lodge a complaint with the Hellenic Data Protection Authority.
